Aims/priorities:

the aim is to support communities to thrive by funding projects that

- **Bring people together**
- **Improve places and spaces that matter to communities**
- **Help more people to reach their potential by supporting them at the earliest possible stage**



Organisations can apply for funding to:

- a. Change and adapt
- b. Continue to deliver activity





MLT will support projects that:

Create accessible and welcoming spaces for people to meet , and initiate inclusive activities

Encourage people to get involved with their community to make a difference to what is important to them

Take a preventative approach, enabling the community to take positive action to improve health and wellbeing

In addition, all applicants must now consider environmental sustainability even when it is not their main area of focus



Examples of what we might fund:

- **create, or refresh an area used for sessions which bring people together**
- **community hub/garden inclusive activities and mentoring for young people**
- **emotional/mental health/wellbeing initiatives**
- **installation of solar panels/additional insulation to help reduce costs and make a positive impact on the environment**

To be eligible for funding applicants must have:

An Isle of Man based bank account which requires two people, who are unrelated and do not live at the same address, to authorise cheques and make withdrawals

At least three members on its governing body or board of directors





Thematic funding size:

The Trust has a total of €150,000 available for Space to Thrive

Your application can be from £2,501 to £25,000 maximum, over 12 months

The deadline for submissions is Friday, 28th February 2025

Applications will be considered by the Trustees on Friday, 14th March 2025
